## **NEWBORN ASSESSMENT - CONDENSED**

Appearance: pink, loud cry, well-flexed, full ROM

**Fontanelles**: anterior (diamond-shaped), posterior (triangular)

**Mouth**: Assess for cleft lip or palate

**Respirations**: Assess breathing

**Extremities**: Equal length, 10 fingers and toes

**Heart**: Assess for murmurs

**Umbilical Cord**: 1 Vein, 2 Arteries, Clamped

## Genitalia:

Male: testes palpable Female: discharge of blood or mucus normal
