## **6 RIGHTS OF MEDICATION ADMINISTRATION**

1	Right Patient	Verify the patient with two patient identifiers (Name, DOB, MRN)
2	Right Drug	Verify that you have the right drug that was ordered (and in the right formula)
3	Right Dose	Verify that you have pulled or drawn up the correct dose that was ordered
4	Right Route	Verify that you are giving it via the ordered route (PO, IV, IM, SubQ)
5	Right Time	Verify the time that the drug was ordered. Drugs should ideally be administered within 30 minutes of ordered time.
6	Right Documentation	Document administration of the medication in the Medication Administration Record

## **BONUS RIGHT:**

Is it the RIGHT thing to do - evaluate the patient's condition and their other medications - is this medication appropriate for them? If you are not comfortable, discuss with the ordering provider.
