FOLEY INSERTION TIPS

Preprocedure

Verify orders
Gather supplies
Perform hand hygiene
Identify patient with 2 patient identifiers (or per policy)
Explain procedure to patient
Raise bed to a comfortable working height

Pro Tips

For Female Patients

- Use your nondominant hand to spread the labia majora and hold them open (don't move your hand once you've held it open!)
 - Always let the patient know you're going to touch them
- Use your *dominant* hand to cleanse the meatus
 - From front to back on the right
 - Front to back on the left
- Front to back down the center
- Look for the 'wink' of the urethral opening as you cleanse
- More of the actual Foley catheter will be visible outside of the body
 - Due to the shorter urinary tract of females

For Male Patients

- Use your nondominant hand to grasp the penis and gently pull upward perpendicular to the patient's body
 - Always let the patient know you're going to touch them
- Use your dominant hand to cleanse the meatus
- Start at the meatus and cleanse in concentric circles around the shaft.
 - Will have to retract the foreskin to clean the meatus
- Less of the actual Foley catheter will be visible outside of the body
 - Due to the longer urinary tract of males

For all patients

- Place opened Foley tray in between patient's legs for easy access
 - Never turn your back to the tray or the patient
- Always secure Foley to the patient with time, date and initial applied to securing device
- Always document
 - Urine color, clarity, and amount
 - Procedure
 - Size of catheter
 - Patient's response/tolerance

Postprocedure

Discard all used supplies in the appropriate waste container
Remove and dispose of gloves
Perform hand hygiene
Return bed to low & locked position
Ensure patient is comfortable
